As you will know, Prime Minister Jacinda Adern announced this evening at 6pm that New Zealand is to move into Level 4 Lockdown this evening at 11.59pm, due to a case of Covid 19 being identified in Auckland. St Mary's School is CLOSED for this Lockdown period of three days.

Level 4 Lockdown will see us move again into Online Home Learning. After Lockdown in 2020, staff prepared for the likelihood that Online Home Learning may possibly become a reality again and we are fully organised for this new current situation.

Online Home Learning will be sent to you by your child's classroom teacher via SeeSaw or Hapara.

Tomorrow morning all class teachers will contact you regarding how they will be communicating with you, regarding your child's learning and then will send to you a Home Learning Programme for your child.
